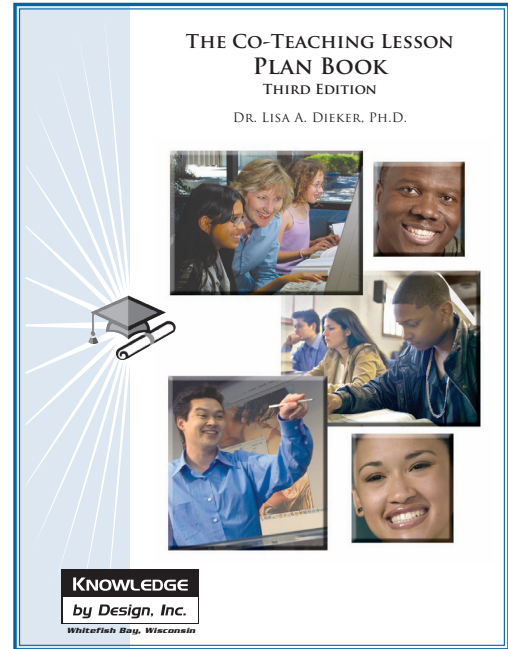
This unique lesson plan book is designed to be completed and shared by a general education teacher and a special education teacher.
