This is especially true for the first 15 centuries, and for Western World theatre. After the 18th century, it is focussed on English theatre. It's not a book for American theatre studies. It pays only lip-service (so to speak) to non-Western theatre. But it does a good job to make the rise of European and English theatre cohesive. It leaves out several important movements and has scant breath for Irish theatre. I still use it for my classes.
