Jan Mukarovsky: 'Aesthetic Function, Norm and.Â Theory is an area of constant debate and confrontation and, to have an adequate understanding of it, it is necessary to have knowledge not merely of the arguments central to one or two particular standpoints but also of alternative positions explicitly or implicitly in conflict with them.Â Theory is therefore always implied in reading literary discourse, since whatever norms and constraints that govern how literary texts are read cannot be seen as an integral part of the discourse itself but are chosen, consciously or unconsciously, from among various possibilities by the reader.

Literary theory empowers us to read texts in a particular way, in order to explore different perspectives, and open up a text to new interpretations. The earliest literary criticism comes from ancient Greek writers such as Plato, Aristotle and Aristophanes. From the early twentieth-century Cambridge School of Empson and I.A. Richards, with their emphasis on close reading divorced from context (though in a very different way from Barthes's later argument), and F.R. Leavis's focus on morality and literary tradition, to later Continental influences of cultural theorists such as Jacques Derrida and Roland Barthes, which often derived from. It behooves the specialists of every literature to examine whether this claim holds water. Again, there's no denying that there is a certain amount of truth in this objection: some ideas that are promoted as being completely novel and unheard of are indeed just a slick version of old concepts, and we have already seen that literary theory is really about fundamental and primeval questions.
